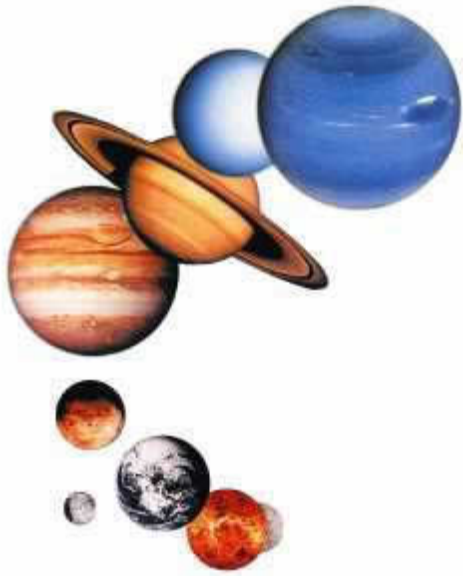
WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP CHECK LIST
