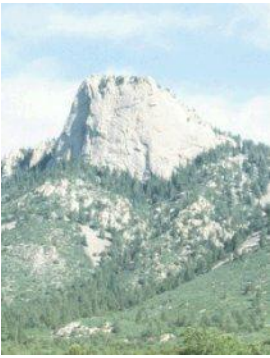

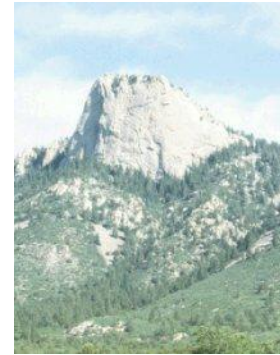

### **Philmont Scout Ranch 2012 June 8<sup>th</sup> - June 22<sup>nd</sup> LaSalle Council High Adventure Backpacking**

The LaSalle Council is looking to send two crews of Scouts to Philmont in 2012. The contingents will spend 13 days hiking the Sangre de Cristo Mountains of Northern New Mexico and participating in the exciting program activities of Scouting's crown jewel, Philmont Scout Ranch.

Programs include: *Rock Climbing, Burro Races & Burro Packing, Indian Lore, Archaeological Digs, Black Powder Shooting, Blacksmithing, Roping and Branding, Panning for Gold, and their choice of 27 different program locations.*

Spend your tour hiking, participating in some of the different Philmont programs, sharing crew responsibilities and leadership with other LaSalle Council scouts in Your Philmont Crew. Experience the mountains, history, western lore, and wilderness, minimum impact camping, and scouting opportunities contained in the 137,000 acres of Philmont Scout Ranch.

24 slots are reserved for youth and adults for 2012, slots are filling up fast, please respond as soon as possible, applications are due by April 1<sup>st</sup> 2011!!

*Please note: Paid reservations and applications are considered on a first come, first serve basis. Staying current with the payment schedule is a prerequisite for contingent participation. Payments are transferable to a new person for this event (not to an existing person), but are not refundable to the extent that expenses have been incurred (payments to Philmont and for transportation arrangements are made many months before the event).*

*Each participant in a Philmont trek must not exceed the maximum acceptable limit in the weight-for-height chart on Philmont's website (<http://www.philmontscoutranch.org/Camping/Advisory.aspx>). Those who fall within the limits are more likely to have an enjoyable trek and avoid incurring health risks. Every Philmont trek involves hiking with a 35 to 50-pound backpack at elevations of 6,500 to 12,500 feet. Philmont recommends that participants carry a pack weighing no more than 25% to 30% of their body weight.*
