camp tamarack at wood lake scout reservation



Wood Lake Scout Reservation is a beautiful large property located in rolling wooded hills just south of Jones, MI.

Overlooking the north side of Big Wood Lake, Camp Tamarack hosts the LaSalle Council Boy Scout Resident Camps in the summer in addition to several weekend events for youth and adults throughout the year.

The camp boasts 2 newly renovated lodges, 16 campsites with water (that can accommodate between 16 and 90 people each), a shower house, rifle and archery ranges, and a dining hall that seats 250.

The OA-Kiwanis Lodge and the Rotary-Naquin Lodge each sleep 24 people in 3 rooms. These newly updated lodges are the perfect choice for larger groups. Amenities include a 4-burner stove-top, fridge, sink, and indoor bathroom with shower.

The lodges offer wonderful amenities such as stovetop and fridge, separate leader rooms, and bathrooms.

Fishing is available from the shore of Wood Lake and boats are available for rent.

Note: Camp Tamarack is not available for rental from Memorial Day through Labor Day due to BSA nationally accredited summer camps.



Scouts who camp overnight at all three camps during a one year period can earn the Tri-Camp Patch.

camp topenebee

Camp Topenebee is a popular camp sheltered by large oaks and tall pines. Facilities include 4 large cabins (sleeping up to 22 people, electricity, wood heat), 14 campsites (holding up to 50 campers), a shooting range, a picnic pavilion and the Horton-Hiler Training Lodge with a capacity of 150.

Go for a hike around camp or experience the 2.6 mile Szczepanski Fitness Trail. You can also enjoy fishing from the new fishing pier at Lake Topenebee. A campfire circle with seating for over 200 is an ideal spot for large groups to end the day.

Camp Topenebee is conveniently located south of Michigan City, Indiana.

camp rice woods

LaSalle Council maintains the 132 acre Camp Rice Woods for rustic camping. This cozy spot is nestled among pines and hardwoods, and boasts abundant wildlife. It offers a large picnic pavilion, 14 campsites (each with space for 4 or 5 tents), and a wood heated cabin with bunks for 16. Water is from an old fashioned pitcher pump.

Camp Rice Woods is located just south of Koontz Lake, Indiana.
