

Boy Scouts of America LaSalle Council Potawatomi District Okama Award

This award is for *Excellence in Committee Chairmanship*. The award is unique to the Potawatomi District and is awarded by any unit to its committee chair who meets the following requirements:

1. Registered as a Committee Chairman for two years.
2. The committee chair must have taken (at least) Scouting's Basic Leader Training for the type of unit they represent.
3. At least 75% of the unit committee and program leaders must be trained.
4. The unit committee must meet at least six times in a charter year, at least four times per year with the chartered organization representative present.
5. The chartered organization head must attend at least one unit or committee meeting per year.
6. The unit must charter on time.
7. The unit must receive the Quality Unit award.
8. The committee chair must meet monthly with the Scout or Cub master.

An application for the *Okama* award must be sent along with a signed letter of recommendation to the chair of the District Recognition committee at least six weeks prior to the annual recognition dinner. Qualified candidates will receive their award at the district annual recognition dinner.
