3. The leader understands that this is a volunteer position.
4. The leader agrees that the principles of the Cub Scout Promise and Law of the Pack must be practiced as a way of life.

- Assist in the program areas as needed to help the boys make the most of their opportunities.
- Be concerned for camper safety.
- Be knowledgeable of the Cub Scout program.
