3. The staff member understands that this is a volunteer position.
4. The staff member agrees that the principles of the Cub Scout Promise and Law of the Pack must be practiced as a way of life.

Program Station Leader

The program station leader shall be a man or woman 21 years of age or older of well-known good character and ability. The unit leader shall:

- Be responsible to the program director.
- Plan and carry out a constructive day camp program in the unit with the advice of the program director and the help of assistants and program aides.
- Teach camping skills and appreciation of the outdoors.
- Coordinate unit activities with those of the entire camp.
- Supervise the unit staff-delegate jobs, guide them in the work, and arrange for coverage during staff absences.
- Supervise unit housekeeping, sanitation, camper health, and safety.
- Be knowledgeable of the Cub Scout program.
