### Stations:

1. fire building
  2. signaling
  3. hypothermia first aide
  4. cooking
  5. orienteering
  6. knots
  7. woods tools
  8. first aide
- Each participating patrol **MUST** complete **ALL STATIONS FOR COMPETITION**.
  - Starting station and rotation will be assigned at registration.
  - Each patrol should bring equipment listed below.
  - Each patrol will have up to 25 minutes at each station.
  - Patrols arriving at a station early will not be allowed to start until the appropriate time.
  - 30 points for each station ( 10 scout spirit, 10 team work, 10 scout skill)

### Chili Cooking:

- Bring chili to training center -- see time schedule for instructions
- Cook up your best chili, bring to be judged by Klondike Derby staff judges
- Label your chili entry with Troop and Patrol number.
- Also label for allergies (peanuts, tree nuts, shellfish, gluten etc.)
- One award for best tasting chili!

### Snow Scout:

- Each patrol will build a Snow Scout, demonstrating a Scout skill/spirit.
- Snow Scout will be built in the parade field.
- **SIGN IN AT TRAINING CENTER WHEN COMPLETED**
- One award for best snow scout.

### Sled judging:

- Each patrol will build a **NEW** sled **EVERY** year.
- Sleds should be made of semi-bark covered wood.
- Binder twine, nylon cord, etc may be used for ladhings.
- Dowel rod or homemade pegs may be used.
- **SLED MUST BE LARGE ENOUGH TO TRANSPORT AN INJURED PERSON.**
- **NO** metal screws, wire, chain or nails (sled example on web klondike pg).
- Sled judging: 30 points possible...10 design, 10 construction, 10 appearance
- There's will be **TWO** sled judgments:
  - 1st at 8:00 am before opening ceremony at training center flag area;
  - 2nd judging after sled race....
- One award for best sled built

Sled Race:

- Best time to run sled route.
- ALL scouts in the patrol help pull the sled...no scout left behind...work as a patrol...show your scout spirit.
- Time starts at the "Go" signal and ends when the LAST patrol member crosses the finish line.
- Top three placing ribbons awarded.
