

LaSalle Council 2023 National Jamboree Troop Leader Application



JOIN THE ADVENTURE: Join more than 30,000 Scouts from all over the country as they enjoy 10,600 acres of wild, wonderful West Virginia at the Summit and find out first hand just what it's like to Live Scouting's Adventure. In addition to providing leadership for a Troop of Scouts from LaSalle Council, leaders will have the opportunity to participate in many of the Jamboree activities and events at the Summit Bechtel Reserve.

DATES: July 19 – July 28, 2023 (Plus travel time, depending on travel arrangements)

QUALIFICATIONS: SEE REVERSE SIDE FOR ADULT LEADER QUALIFICATIONS. LEADERS FOR THE JAMBOREE WILL BE CONSIDERED BASED ON QUALIFICATIONS, THEIR SUBMITTED SCOUTING RESUMÉ AND AN INTERVIEW TO BE CONDUCTED BEFORE THE SELECTION PROCESS IS COMPLETED.

To be considered, you must include a Scouting resumé that is at least one full page detailing your Scouting background (Scouting Leadership, camping, jamborees, high adventure experience along with training, awards earned, tenure, etc), community and religious background and experience.

JAMBOREE FEE: \$2,300 for Scouts and Leaders. Make no payment now – by submitting this application, you agree to all terms and requirements, and to stay current with payment schedule if selected.

REFUND POLICY: If you are selected for a Jamboree leadership position and find you cannot attend, you will receive a full refund from LaSalle Council “only if” there is an alternate to take your place. In the event there is not an alternate available, a partial refund will be made, and includes the fees you have paid to date, “minus” any expenses related to contractual agreements made on your behalf. Anyone 2 months or more behind in their payments will forfeit their position.

Jamboree Leader Qualifications

All Jamboree Scoutmasters, First, Second and Third Assistant Scoutmasters must meet the following requirements:

- Have a current BSA membership with a Boy Scout troop.
- Be approved by the local council.
- Complete Youth Protection Training within one year of the last day of the Jamboree.
- Meet the medical and BMI requirements of the Jamboree.
- Participate and assist in planning the pre-Jamboree training experience with their local council.

All leaders must file a BSA Health & Medical Record with their council within one year of attending the Jamboree.

Scoutmasters and First Assistant Scoutmasters must be at least 21 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree. Second Assistant Scoutmasters must be at least 18 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree.

Third Assistant Scoutmasters must be at least 18 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree but not yet 21 years of age by the last day of the Jamboree.

Scoutmaster applicants must be currently serving as a Scoutmaster.

First, Second or Third Assistant Scoutmasters must currently be serving in any adult troop or team leadership position. Scoutmaster applicants must have completed Scoutmaster leader specific training.
