














Sakima Lodge Event Pins



This year, the new style of event memorabilia will continue to be used by Sakima Lodge. The Lodge Executive Committee created the idea of one single year event patch that would be a representation for all events of that Lodge year. So, that means once you've attended your first event you have the base layer for that year's event patches. In addition to the base patch, for each event you attend or task you complete you will receive a pin that is unique to each event or task. The pin requirements are:

<p>Exceptional Service Pin  See the requirement sheet on the next page</p>	<p>You can only earn one of each pin each year, however the Lodge encourages exceptional and above and beyond service and involvement. Event pins and the Brotherhood pin are to be worn in the calendar year of which they are earned. The Ceremonies pin and the Exceptional Service pin are meant to be on the event patch the following year after receiving the pin.</p>	

Arrowmen (youth and adult) can work on these requirements from January 1st through December 31st of the same calendar year. Use this card to track your progress and have your chapter adviser initial as requirements are completed.
